

# Leading Together

The Jesuits have a new leader—Fr. Adolfo Nicolás (see page 27). They also have an urgent message for everyone concerned about the work of the Society of Jesus: “Many hands are surely needed.”

Those words rang out from the 35th General Congregation of the Society of Jesus held earlier this year in Rome. In one of their decrees emanating from the gathering, delegates were calling for greater collaboration among all those dedicated to Jesuit ideals. It was a call for nothing less than shared leadership.

Leadership, for Jesuits, begins in the Province. Whether in New England or Amman, Jordan, it is the Province that sends Jesuits into ministry. It is the Province that takes men on a journey through five stages of formation lasting no fewer than 10 years. At all times, Jesuits are called to embody traits of leadership that are distinctively Ignatian, practices such as self-reflection and care for the person to whom they are ministering. That is, for the *whole* person: mind, body, and spirit.

Today, many others are being formed in the ways of Ignatian leadership. They are helping people find God in all things, and in all places, from boardrooms and nursing homes to classrooms and retreat houses. The New England Province is doing all this, and more, in collaboration with members of the extended Ignatian family—lay men and women pursuing their callings as people of faith.

Together with Jesuits, these collaborators are reaching out to the poor and vulnerable, but also to their peers. Some are working with recent college graduates hoping to stay connected to Ignatian spirituality, others with business leaders hoping to reconnect. In many fields of mission, they are doing as Jesuits have done for over 450 years—leading with love.

In the Ignatian worldview, leadership is scarcely about power and position. It is primarily a form of ministry, a way of serving God’s people and nurturing the greater good. That has been the secret ingredient of Jesuit success through the centuries. It is what keeps them and their friends—all those who support this work—in the company of leaders.



# Growing in Freedom

## Ordination



The wonderful thing about Jesuit formation is that it's not rushed," says Fr. Joseph Redfield Palmisano, SJ, revealing a knack for understatement. He is the newest priest in the New England Province, ordained this past June at Fairfield University after a decade of formation taking him from Connecticut to Ireland to Jamaica and back again. "You're given time to grow, to grow in freedom, so you could be available to serve," Fr. Palmisano says of the winding Jesuit path. At 33, the Connecticut native is back in Dublin for doctoral work in theology, focusing on Catholic-Jewish dialogue.

### *Jubilee*

Long ago they were called to a different kind of family—the Jesuit community. These twenty-eight members of the Province celebrated their Jubilee anniversaries in September 2007, marking either their entrance into the Society of Jesus or their priestly ordinations. Joining them at Boston College High School were 500 friends and relatives. In his homily, Fr. Bruce Morrill, SJ, of Boston College’s theology department, pointed to the toddlers playing in the back of the McNeice Pavilion at BC High. He said they, and those in wheelchairs—all God’s people—have received an invitation from Jesus “to be members of his family, the body of the Church, constantly converted to the vision of his Kingdom.”





## *Love-Driven Leadership*

Since the founding of their first school in 1548, Jesuits have been teaching young people how to be men and women for and with others. They have shown how to “go out and set the world aflame” in the spirit (and words) of St. Ignatius Loyola.

That mission continues today with a thriving array of colleges, universities, high schools, and middle schools—including the Nativity Schools that have recently sprouted across the United States. These middle schools are reaching out to inner-city students in such places as Boston (under the sponsorship of the New England Province) and Worcester, Massachusetts (under the co-sponsorship of the Province and the College of the Holy Cross).

And, the mission continues despite fewer men being called to ordained life.

In recent years a growing flock of lay men and women have stepped into leadership ranks of Jesuit

education. One of these collaborators is Donna Andrade, who began what she calls “my ministry” of Jesuit education nearly three decades ago. Now she is academic dean of Fairfield College Preparatory School in Connecticut, where, among other roles, she helps inculcate new teachers in the distinctive methodologies of Jesuit education.


Andrade says she has learned about leadership from Jesuits. She likes to speak of them as persons “with” others, because they have walked with her through every stride of her discernment in life and work.

“They have given me the freedom and the room to be myself, completely myself—which is what we’re trying to do with the students,” Andrade says of the Jesuits she has known.

This is “love-driven leadership,” she points out, and it has molded her ministry, “because I’m not just teaching a subject. I’m teaching to the whole person—helping them [the students] to be whole.”

Andrade has also helped make Jesuit education more “whole,” in part by advising secondary schools (not just her own) on ways of promoting greater racial and socioeconomic diversity. She says: “I feel that I’m a small part of a big, big wheel that’s doing tremendously good things in the world.”





## *Bringing Together Faith and Firm*

**M**any business people struggle on a spiritual and ethical level with tough decisions about their organizations. But where can they go to talk with peers about the dilemmas they face as both business leaders and people of faith?

Principle Centered Leadership and Ignatian Conversations for Business Executives is a new forum carved out for this purpose by the New England Province of the Society of Jesus. Guided by the Provincial, Fr. Thomas J. Regan, SJ, the conversations are one way of bridging the divide between faith and firm.

This initiative is of a piece with other efforts by the Province to help people stay connected to Ignatian spirituality. Among these works are the Jesuit Connection, which helps young adults continue their growth spiritually within the Jesuit tradition; and the Jesuit Collaborative, an unprecedented network of lay people seeking to share Jesuit values and spiritual practices with others (see page 24).

Principle Centered Leadership is the latest response by the New England Province to this desire to go further along the Ignatian path. In its first year, the project has yielded three events attracting corporate leaders. For example, 175 people turned out for an April event where Chris Lowney, author of *Heroic Leadership* (Loyola Press), spoke of how Jesuit principles can help nurture dynamic leadership.



Organizers of the effort are also setting their sights on small-group conversations drawing on Ignatian spiritual tools. Key among these is the five-step “Examen,” which encourages self-reflection and concrete ways of cooperating with God’s plan.

“There’s a real hunger for relating the spirituality you learned earlier in life to the decisions you make today at work,” says John J. Mahoney, Jr., Chief Financial Officer of Staples, Inc., who learned from Jesuits earlier in his life. “There’s a great willingness and pent-up desire to discuss these issues.”

Mahoney has stepped forward in this initiative with fellow College of the Holy Cross alumnus William J. Teuber, Jr., Vice Chairman of EMC Corporation. Teuber says Principle Centered Leadership offers executives an “opportunity to step back and reflect on principles that have been important in their lives,” and on how they could share those principles with others.



## *Caring All Their Days*

Jesuits are with people at all passages in life, from the baptismal fonts in parishes to classrooms in college, from the dark cells of prisons to bedsides in hospitals. New England Jesuits are ministering in these and many other settings, reaching all the way to missions in the Middle East and military bases around the world.

As people journey into older age, they continue to feel the pastoral touch of Jesuits—including those Jesuits who themselves are in need of a helping hand.

Fr. William Raftery, SJ, is one such giver. Until this past summer, the 82-year-old priest was chaplain at a nursing home of the Little Sisters of the Poor in Somerville, Mass., where there are nearly 100 residents, including some nuns.

When he began that assignment nearly five years ago, Fr. Raftery was no stranger to either the Little Sisters or elderly ministry.

His own “little” sister, Patricia (Sister Emily of the Assumption), has belonged to the community for 50 years, serving in the missions, now in Malaysia. His mother lived her last days at the Somerville home, while Fr. Raftery was (from 1989 to 1996) rector of Campion Center in Weston, Mass., a residence for more than 70 older and infirm Jesuits.

Always, his approach has been to “care for people as if they were my mother or father.”



What’s changed is that Fr. Raftery is now (partly) on the receiving end. With medical needs of his own, in July he took up residence on Campion’s assisted-living floor. This transition, he admits, has been difficult, and yet, “I appreciate being able to back off a little now.”

He continues ministering to parishioners nearby and to fellow Jesuits who require intensive care at Campion. Of the Jesuit routine there, Fr. Raftery says: “Every possible way that we could help—apart from what nurses and doctors do—we do it.”

## “Live Your Life for Others”

**T**om White, widely known as the construction tycoon who gave away his fortune, was presented with the annual Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam Award together with his wife, Lois, this past April. Sponsored by the New England Province of the Society of Jesus, the award honors those who selflessly give of themselves “for the greater glory of God” (White’s causes have ranged from healthcare in Haiti to Jesuit education in Boston). The couple was feted at the Jesuit GALA, which brought 1,000 people to the Boston Marriott Copley Place. Among them were all 18 of White’s grandchildren. The 2008 Jesuit GALA raised \$1.2 million to support the ministries of the New England Province—which gratefully acknowledges each of the givers.







# A Successor to Loyola




For four days in January they prayed and took part in the quiet conversation known as *murmurationes*. In the end the 217 Jesuit electors gathered in Rome chose Fr. Adolfo Nicolás as the 30th Superior General of the Society of Jesus—the 29th successor to St. Ignatius Loyola, who founded the Jesuits in 1540. Father Nicolás was formerly President of the Jesuit Conference of East Asia and Oceania (which includes Australia) as well as Jesuit provincial of

Japan. As Jesuit general, Fr. Nicolás—who became fluent in English while staying at Shadowbrook, the former New England novitiate in Lenox, Mass.—succeeds Fr. Peter-Hans Kolvenbach, SJ. Noting the Spanish-born Jesuit’s extensive knowledge of cultures and faiths worldwide, New England Provincial Fr. Thomas Regan, SJ, observes, “Most of all, he is clearly a man of deep prayer.”




